Zeev Zalevsky received his B.Sc. and direct Ph.D. degrees in electrical engineering from Tel-Aviv University in 1993 and 1996 respectively. Zeev is currently a full Professor and the Vice Dean in the faculty of engineering in Bar-Ilan University, Israel. His major fields of research are optical super resolution, biomedical optics and nano-photonics.

Zeev has published more than 450 refereed journal papers (including papers in journals such as Progress in Optics, Nano Letters, Nano scale, Scientific Reports, Nature Photonics, Nature Communication etc), more than 250 conference proceeding papers, more than 400 international presentations, more than 50 issued patents, 6 authored books, 3 books as an editor, and 30 book chapters.

For his work he has received many national and international prizes and awards such as ICO prize, Juludan prize, Krill prize, Image engineering innovation award and more. Zeev is also a fellow of many scientific societies as OSA, SPIE, EOS, IET, IOP, IS&T and NANOSMAT. Zeev is also a Fellow of the National Academy of Inventors.
