### **“Traditional”**

The RecoverPoint splitter code, written by the IF Splitters team, utilizes the capabilities of state-of-the-art intelligent FC switches to protect the data that flows through them. These switches control the entire data flow through the SAN, routing information and replicating it at the same time. Platforms team uses the APIs these switches expose to ensure this data is safe from harm, no matter what happens to the environment.

The challenges involve writing sophisticated code that translates between replication needs to switch terms. This code is object-oriented, design-pattern governed, but still has to be low-level enough to be in control of SCSI traffic flow and handle it correctly. Also, there is constant interaction with switch vendors ensuring that the API they provide has all we need to provide replication semantics.

### **“New”**

The team will develop a new state of the art log collection system. The system should be able to handle huge logs collected from a distributed multi platform system.

The team will take part of other development activities taken on by the IF Splitters team as needed. The team will also take on new responsibilities along time.

Team members will be expected to provide robust, maintainable and extendable code that will serve for years to come and enable future enhancements. The team will be expected to work independently, resolve technical issues on its own and carry on research activities.
