

# BPJ Installation Guide

## 1. BPJ Installation

1. Download the BPJ Eclipse projects file (bpj.zip).
2. Import the archive file into a new project in Eclipse:
  - (a) Click: File → Import → (General)Existing Projects into Workspace → Select Archive File
  - (b) Locate and double click on the file you downloaded in step 1.
  - (c) Click Finish.
3. Test the installation with “Hello, World!”
  - (a) Click on BPJ project.
  - (b) Click the Run icon.
  - (c) Select Run as Java Application
  - (d) Select HelloWorld
  - (e) You should see six events scrolling by – alternating good morning and good evening.
  - (f) Stop the running application.
4. Test the installation with Tic-Tac-Toe
  - (a) Click on TicTacToe.
  - (b) Click the Run icon. You should see a Tic-Tac-Toe game board.
  - (c) Click on any square to mark it with an X. The computer marks squares with O.
  - (d) Play Tic-Tac-Toe.
  - (e) To start a new game stop and restart the application.
